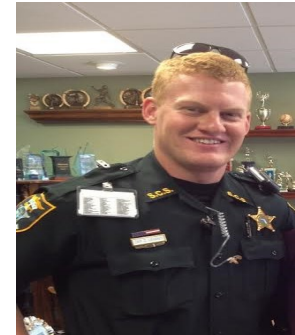




Riverview Presents to the Riverview High School Foundation

The Objective (“The Why”): Based on data, our academic priorities involve increasing the success of each and every student at Riverview. Our goal is to graduate 100% of our students by supporting them and embracing their changing needs. We want each and every student to be college and career ready. Each student would have a School Counselor and a College and Career Counselor. Riverview would focus on each student’s short-term and long-term goals.

Mission: To fund 2 College and Career Counselors

The Need: Each of our counselors currently works with over 400 students while the suggested standard is 250 to allow counselors the maximum opportunity to work with students. We have one college and career specialist who is now responsible for working with all 2,500 students. We need college counselor with expertise to assist our students.

Responsibilities of the College and Career Counselors

- Assist students with college and career planning
- Build a college and career resource center for all students
- Assist students with transition to post-secondary transitions
- Assist students with college applications
- Assist students with financial planning for post-secondary opportunities
- Host workshops for students and families providing assistance and detailed information regarding post-secondary opportunities and transition
- Assist students with college visits
- Use Naviance as a guide to support students and their families
